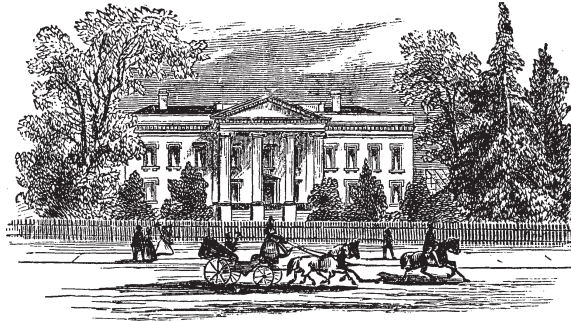
If you are interested in trying it out for a weekend, many units have extra "loaner" gear that they can let you use for a day.

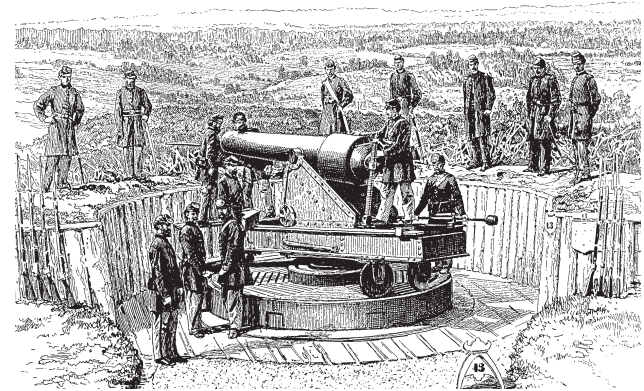

PLEASE BE CAREFUL WHILE YOU VISIT

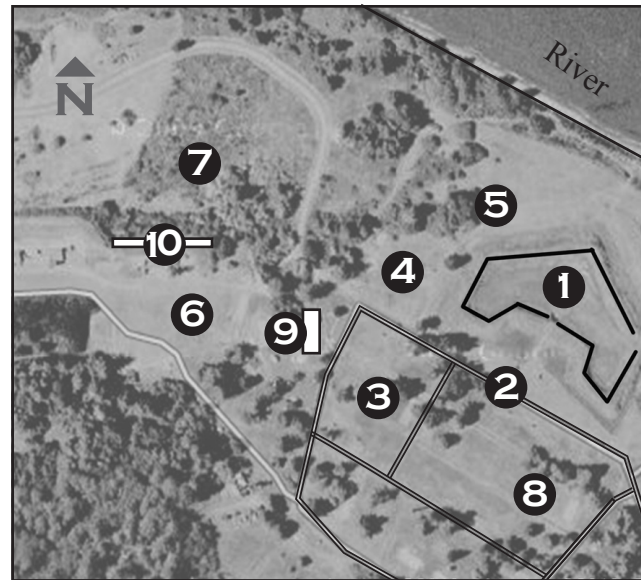
- Adults should supervise children at all times.
